Earlier this year, Shipley College and our project partner, the Saltaire Collection, were allocated government funding by the Shipley Town Fund Board to develop proposals for a Community, Arts, Heritage and Future Technology Centre in the heart of Saltaire. This is a significant opportunity to create a new community building that will serve local people and visitors to Saltaire in the sensitive historical context of a World Heritage Site.

The new Centre is to be located at the corner of Victoria Road and Caroline Street and it will provide additional classroom and administration space to support the expanding curriculum of the College. It will also become the new home for the Saltaire Collection and will provide improved working areas and storage for their large collection of historic artefacts and documents, as well as a public exhibition space and community classroom to help engage and inform people about the history of Saltaire and its local community.

We are planning to begin building work in August 2023 and to be open in August 2024 in advance of Bradford's year as City of Culture in 2025.




